 APPLICATION FOR MODIFICATION OF THE
 PRETREATMENT PROGRAM OF THE VILLAGE OF JEFFERSON

Notice is hereby given that the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency has determined that the request submitted by Village of Jefferson for the development and implementation of industrial user local limits meets the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-3-03(C).

Purpose, Abbreviated: Local Industrial Discharge Limitations

Purpose, Expanded: The Village of Jefferson has proposed to implement local limits as Maximum Allowable Industrial Loads (MAIL). The combined loading of each pollutant from industrial users shall not exceed the following limits:

*These limits are technically based in order to prevent pass-through water quality violations, contamination of sludge, and the inhibition of biological wastewater treatment processes.

In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-3-03(F), all interested persons are entitled to submit written comments and/or request a public hearing concerning the application. Written comments and requests for public hearing must be submitted to the Ohio EPA, at the address provided below, by the close of business on January 6, 2022, in order to be considered as part of the record of proceeding.

The Ohio EPA will review all requests for a public hearing and determine whether there is significant public interest. If significant public interest exists, a public hearing will be scheduled. A public notice of any public hearing will be provided to allow all interested persons an opportunity to attend the meeting.

After a review of the application and of public comments submitted with respect to the application, the Director will issue an official action approving or denying the application. However, the Regional Administrator for the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region V, may also disapprove the application under procedures for filing objections to the Application under 40 CFR 403.11(d). If the application is to be approved, procedures will be implemented to incorporate the modification to the approved pretreatment program to Village of Jefferson National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.
